



## Sharing information in the Youth Sector

The State-wide Youth Collaborative Group (SYC) has developed this poster to support the distribution of information in the youth sector in Tasmania. SYC is a group of government and non government organisations that meet to improve collaboration in the youth sector. SYC is shared by the Youth Network of Tasmania (YNOT) and Population Health, DHHS.

YNOT is the peak body for the Tasmanian youth sector. YNOT supports three regional youth coordinating groups that bring together people in the sector.

## Distributing electronic information

Each of the regional youth coordinating groups (YAP, NYCC and NWAY) have a distribution list for those who attend the regional meetings and some of the lists are also used as a more general distribution point for information relevant to the youth sector. Being part of your regional group means you can receive information as well as have a great way to distribute your information.

## Getting the best out of information sharing

As well as receiving lots of useful information you may choose to send info out to others in the sector. Managing distribution lists is a huge workload load for those who do this. You can help by making sure your emails are clear and appropriate for distribution to those working with young people.

- subject headings in emails - people will often chose whether or not to open your email based on the heading – make it count!
- youth specific info only
- include some of the key info in the body of email, not just in attachment
